29 Pray today for Mari McCormick and the staff of Karis Pizza in Moldova who work to serve the community by providing a friendly, safe place for people to meet in. Pray for strength and encouragement for the hard working staff there.

30 David Roderick is leading training today for the team from Christchurch, Clifton, Bristol, who will be going to Romania in August to help at the Emanuel Hospice children's summer camp.

1 Our partner Sergey Obydenniy in Russia works in Kabardino-Balkaria Republic, an area in which there are people of many nationalities. He has asked us to pray for Arthur, a Gypsy Christian, who visits several Gypsy families and wants to develop a ministry among them. Gypsies are under strong influences from family and relatives and are not easily allowed by them to attend church. Pray that God will protect and equip Arthur for his outreach to these Gypsy families.

2 Thank God for the Gypsy people who have come to faith in Christ and are able to get to church. Pray that their faith may be strengthened, despite the many obstacles they face.

3 Please pray for Michael, a colleague of Sergey Obydenniy, who desires to reach out as a witness to Turkish families. Pray for protection and inspiration for Michael as he visits several Turkish families and seeks to share the love of God with them.

4 Please pray with us today for the church of our partners in Turkey. Ask God to give wisdom and guidance to the leaders as they oversee the body of Christ there.

5 Thank God today for all the church leaders in Turkey who have been trained to run an Alpha course. Pray that they will be able to use what they have learnt to encourage and equip God's church there.

6 Pray for the plans to hold Alpha training courses in key cities in Turkey. Ask God to guide those who will be organising these courses and also to keep them safe.

7 7th-11th is Alpha Training week at Holy Trinity Brompton Church in London. A number of our partners will be attending. Please pray for Sally Bertram as she meets up with them (on 7th and 8th) to catch up with news and strengthen friendships.

8 Please pray for all of our partners at the Alpha Training week. Pray that these days will be inspirational for them and that they will be able to return home encouraged and envisioned.

9 Please pray for our partners who have left families behind while they are in London. Ask God to protect their families and give them peace.

10 Pray today for Sally Bertram as she speaks at the ladies' meeting at Pip 'n' Jay Church, Bristol.

11 Project Romanian Rescue (PRR) have a new team member in Florin. He brings youth work experience, music leading and computer skills with him and is already well known and loved by the rest of the team. Please pray for Florin and his wife and child as he settles into his new role.

12 PRR are looking to rent a building in Constanta in order to house a much-needed day centre and offices. Please pray that God will enable them to find a suitable building for their needs.

13 Please pray that God will supply PRR with the funds they need to carry out their invaluable work with street children. Pray particularly that they may find more regular donors and suffer less financial crises.

14 Remember those today who are preparing to run a camp for children this summer. Ask God to give them wisdom as they plan and prepare.

15 Pray for the children who will be attending a summer camp. Pray that each child may be greatly encouraged by the experience and that it will help them to understand how much God loves them.



16 Please pray for those who will staff the summer camps. Pray that through their care each child will have a wonderful and safe time.

17 Please pray for our partners' churches as they plan summer programmes of outreach, open-air evangelism and other such events. Pray that God will bless their plans.

18 Please pray for Monika Mahr as she oversees CASA Grace in Oradea, Romania. Pray for wisdom for her as she manages this work.

19 Please pray for Monika's family. Ask God to bless them and to enable them to enjoy much needed times of relaxation together.

20 Please pray for David Roderick who is speaking at Etloe Chapel in Bristol. Also, the Bulgarian Partners Trust, who support Teddy and Didi Oprenov and their work in Sofia Baptist Church are holding a prayer time this afternoon in Bristol. Please join them in praying for Teddy and Didi.

21 Please pray for the new young people who have been attending Sofia Baptist Church lately. Some of these are orphans who have turned 18 and now live independently in Sofia. Pray that the friendships between the newcomers and the young people of the church will thrive and that in due course a number will come to know Jesus as Saviour.
